CADI Parents and Supporters Activities

This year we are offering planned parent activities during the two rider training days. Our hope is that this will give friends and families the chance to explore Boston and our riders an opportunity to develop close relationships with their trainers, assistant trainers, horses and peers. Both days, we will be provided coach bus transportation on both days. We ask that you be ready at Bear Spot by 8:45 AM. You will be back at Bear Spot by 2 PM each afternoon.

Day 1: July 28th

On the first day, we will go into Boston for a Duck Tour to see Boston from both land and water. The tour uses WWII amphibious landing vehicles, lasts 80 minutes and includes 36 historic sites. After the Duck Tour, we will go to Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market for lunch. Faneuil Hall is right on Boston's Freedom Trail and Quincy Market has more than 100 shops and pushcarts.

Day 2: July 29th

The second day, we will go to Dover Saddlery. Dover is one of the largest and most trusted tack stores in the United States. Dover will give you a chance to purchase any equipment you might be missing and also get everything you might need for freestyle day and color teams. After Dover, we will go to the Concord River for a catered lunch before returning to the farm.
